

NOTICE FOR THE ALLOCATION OF THREE (3) RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS (BI) IN THE SCOPE OF THE ID+ RESEARCH CENTER OF THE IPCA POLO

1. Reference:

IPCA|ID+|BI-02/2022|UIDP/04057/2020

2. Number of vacancies:

Three vacancies (3).

3. Project:

Programmatic project: UIDP/04057/2020, within the scope of the program contract for multiannual financing of the R&D unit 2020-2023, signed between FCT and the R&D unit, ID+ of the IPCA pole.

The Institute for Research in Design Media and Culture (ID+), the R&D unit of the Higher School of Design (ESD) of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave (IPCA), opens a competition for the award of three (3) research grants (BI) for students enrolled and enrolled in a Master's course in the scientific areas of the ESD, under the FCT Research Grant Regulation (RBI) and the Research Grant Holder Statute (EBI) and the IPCA Scientific Research Grant Regulation (RBIC).

The grants awarded under this call will be financed by national funds through the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT), the Ministry of Science, Technology and Higher Education (MCTES) and PIDDAC under the program contract for multi-annual funding. of the R&D unit 2020-2023, signed between FCT and the R&D unit, ID+ of the IPCA pole, with reference to the programmatic project: UIDP/04057/2020.

4. Scientific area(s):

Design, or related areas.

5. Admission requirements and preferential conditions:

5.1. Candidates must meet the following requirements, cumulatively:

- Must be enrolled in a master's, an integrated master's or doctoral degree or enrolled in a course that does not confer an academic degree, namely advanced training courses or postgraduate courses, in accordance with the legal regime established in the numbers 3 to 6 of article 4 of Decree-Law no. 74/2006, of 24 March, and;
- The candidate must have a degree in Design or similar areas (*),

5.2. Preferential conditions

- be a student enrolled in a master's course in the areas of the Higher School of Design of the IPCA;
- have a degree (*) in Design, or similar areas, with a final course average of at least 14 points;
- Academic or professional experience in the scientific areas of the competition.

() If the qualification was granted by a foreign higher education institution, it must be recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution, pursuant to article 25 of Decree-Law No. 66/2018, of 16 August, which approves the legal regime for the recognition of academic degrees and higher education diplomas, awarded by foreign higher education institutions and subparagraph e) of paragraph 2 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 60/2018, of 3 August, and any formalities established therein must be completed by the date of the contracting act.*

*(**) Similar areas are those defined by the jury at its first meeting, as stated in the minutes, whose consultation may be requested by any candidate.*

6. Work plan and scientific orientation of the grants:

The work plan has as its main task the development of a research project on a strategic theme for ID+, IPCA pole, with a view to awarding a master's degree in the areas of the Higher School of Design of the IPCA, according to the ID+ website <https://idmais.org/pt-pt/>.

7. Applicable legislation and regulations:

Research Fellowship Statute – Decree-Law no. 89/2013, which was later amended by Decree-Law no. 123/2019, of August 28. Scholarship holder status in force: (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/estatutobolseiro>) and Regulation of Research Grants of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave, Regulation no. 821/2020 (Diary of the Republic No. 191/2020, Series II of 2020-09-30).

8. Workplace:

The work will be developed at the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave under the scientific guidance of the respective supervisor of the master's research project (integrated member of ID+ IPCA).

9. Duration of the fellowship:

The scholarship will last for six (6 months), on an exclusive, non-renewable basis. The scholarship is scheduled to start in november 2022.

10. Amount of monthly maintenance allowance:

Scholarship holders receive a monthly allowance of €875.98, in accordance with the FCT scholarship value table https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/Tabela_de_Valores_SMM_2022.pdf and according to Annex III of the Regulation of Research Grants of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave, according to the update authorized by order of the President of the IPCA of 2022. This payment will be paid monthly by bank transfer.

11. Other benefits:

Reimbursement of the voluntary social security, corresponding to the 1st. Level of contributory tax base and personal accident insurance.

12. Evaluation of applications:

Applications will be evaluated considering the selection criteria listed below on a scale of 0 to 20 values.

In case of withdrawal of the selected scholarship holder, another candidate will be automatically called from the ordination and ranking list, in order of the best classification, and so on sequentially until the vacancies are exhausted.

13. Evaluation and selection criteria and procedures:

13.1. Evaluation

The assessment considers the merit of the candidate in terms of academic degrees, curricular assessment and research proposal presented by the candidate, in which:

- Curricular assessment (AC), which corresponds to 40% of the weighting;
- Research proposal (PI), which corresponds to 60% of the weighting.

a. Defining the following evaluation criteria:

- Curricular assessment (AC):
 - i. Final grade of the degree, 50%;

- ii. Frequency and/or completion of training actions in the scientific area of the research project, 25%;
- iii. Participation and/or development of extracurricular projects in the scientific area of the research project, 25%.

- Research proposal (PI):

- a) Breadth of knowledge in the areas of the contest, 30%;
- b) Relevance of the research proposal, index of alignment with the ID+ objectives and potential for internal enhancement and/or additionality of the expected results, 50%;
- c) Clarity in the elaboration of objectives and ability to articulate and summarize the proposal, 20%.

13.2. The final classification will be calculated according to the following formula:

$$(0,4*AC) + (0,6*PI)$$

13.3. In the event of a tie, preference will be given to the classification obtained in the research proposal (PI) and in the event of a tie, preference will be given to the oldest student in age.

The jury may not award scholarships if the quality of the candidates is lower than intended.

14. Composition of the Selection Jury:

Effective Members:

President – Professor Paula Cristina de Almeida Tavares, Vice-President of IPCA;

1st member – Professor Doctor Jorge Manuel Lopes Brandão Pereira, Director of the Higher School of Design;

2nd member – Professor Demétrio Ferreira Matos, Adjunct Professor at Higher School of Design;

Alternate Members:

1st member – Professor Miguel Machado de Sá Abreu Terroso, Adjunct Professor at Higher School of Design;

2nd member – Professor Cristiana Rodrigues Serejo, Adjunct Professor at Higher School of Design.

In case of impediment of the President of the Jury, this will be replaced by the first effective member, being called the substitute member to replace the effective member.

Minutes of the selection jury's meetings will be produced by the responsibility of all its members.

15. Reserve/alternate list:

In the event of cancellation or withdrawal of the scholarship, up to 6 months after its attribution, by decision of the project supervisor, the authorization of the President of the IPCA may be proposed for the vacancy(s) to be filled. (s) by the candidate(s) from the list of alternates, according to the final order.

16. Application deadlines:

The contest is open for a period of 10 working days after publication on the website <https://euraxess.ec.europa.eu>.

17. Form of submission of applications:

Applications must be formalized, mandatorily, by email to idmais_poloipca@ipca.pt, indicating the tender reference in Subject: **IPCA|ID+|BI- 02/2022|UIDP/04057/2020**.

Applications must be formalized, mandatorily, through a specific form accompanied by the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae, indicating the frequency and/or completion of training activities in the scientific area of the research project and an indication of which extracurricular projects in the scientific area of the research project in which he participated;
- Portfolio of artistic and/or project realization, if the candidate has one;
- Research proposal, which must include the following elements, in a maximum of 1000 words: title, objectives, methodology, results and bibliography;
- Qualification certificates for the academic degrees held, specifying the final classification and, if possible, the classifications obtained in all subjects taken.

For degrees obtained abroad, record of recognition of academic degrees awarded by foreign higher education institutions and record of conversion of the respective final classification to the Portuguese classification scale. Proof of enrollment in a master's degree must be presented until the grant is contracted;

- Letter of interest;
 - Declaration that the candidate is not, at the same time, a beneficiary of any other grant or, being that the existence of an agreement between the funding entities must be mentioned;
 - Any other document that the candidate deems relevant for the assessment of its merits.
- Applications sent by other means or extemporaneous and incorrectly instructed will not be accepted.

18. Stakeholder participation:

The Draft Final Ranking List is notified to candidates, by e-mail with receipt of delivery of the notification, to comment for the purpose of holding the hearing of interested parties, under the terms of article 121 and following of the Code of Procedure. Administrative, to email idmais_poloipca@ipca.pt. In the absence of pronouncement of the candidates, the final ordination project is considered automatically approved.

19. Decision:

After the deadline for the prior hearing has elapsed, or after the issues raised in this context have been considered, the jury draws up the final ranking list of the admitted candidates, submitting it, together with the remaining parts of the procedure, to the approval of the President of the IPCA.

20. Publication/notification of results:

All candidates will be notified via the email indicated on the application form, of the admission and assessment results, with receipt of delivery of the notification, pursuant to article 19, no.1 of Regulation of Research Grants of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave.

The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through a list ordered by final grade obtained, posted in a visible and public place of the IPCA, on the IPCA electronic page in the menu of the Human Resources Division <https://ipca.pt/>.

21. Complaint:

From the final ordering list, duly approved, a complaint can be made to the President of the IPCA, to be submitted within 15 working days from the notification to the email [jdmais_poloipca@ipca.pt.](mailto:jdmais_poloipca@ipca.pt), which has no suspensive effect.

22. Non-discrimination and equal access policy:
