

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE AWARD OF 5 (FIVE) RESEARCH GRANTS IN THE CONTEXT OF R&D PROJECTS AND INSTITUTIONS

Reference: IPCA-ESG-CICF-5BI-2024-A&FSummerSchool

Number of vacancies: 5 vacancies

R&D Unit: Research Centre on Accounting and Taxation (CICF)

A call for applications is open for the award of five Research Grants (BI), within the scope of the R&D unit Research Centre on Accounting and Taxation (CICF), funded by national funds through FCT/MCTES (PIDDAC) with the reference UIDP/04043/2020, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Accounting, Taxation, Management or related areas

Admission Requirements:

- The candidates must be enrolled in a master's, an integrated master's or a doctoral degree or enrolled in a course that does not confer an academic degree, namely advanced training courses or postgraduate courses, in accordance with the legal regime established in the numbers 3 to 6 of article 4 of Decree-Law no. 74/2006, of 24 March, in a higher education institution, in the areas of Accounting, Taxation, Management or related areas.
- Full-time and exclusive availability.
- Interest in scientific research.

Work plan:

The work plan is part of the "Accounting and Finance Summer School 2024" and aims to integrate students in CICF R&D activities and projects. The work plan of the "Accounting and Finance Summer School 2024" will be organized into two components: training and research. The training component will be based on thematic *workshops* and short-term seminars, lectured by integrated and collaborating researchers of CICF and guest speakers who collaborate with the R&D unit.

Regarding the research component (called *Hands-On*), young researchers will be integrated into R&D projects and activities to be developed at the CICF and must carry out a short-term

R&D project oriented to the project's objectives. The course will culminate with the individual oral presentation of the research work developed and the results achieved by the students.

Applicable legislation and regulations: Research Fellow Statute – Law nº40/2004, of August 18, in its current wording.

- Regulation of Research Grants of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave, approved by Order no. 12952/2023 (Diário da República no. 242/2023, Series II of 2023-12-18).

Workplace: The work will be developed at the premises of the Research Centre on Accounting and Taxation of the School of Management of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave, under the scientific guidance of the integrated members of the CICF. Other researchers may be invited to join the mentoring teams in order to increase collaboration with other national and international institutions.

Duration of the fellowships: The fellowships will last for 3 months, scheduled to start in July 2024. The scholarship contract may eventually be renewed up to a maximum of 3 months, provided that the applicant meets the requirements predicted, up to the maximum time limit in which funding for the project is assured and it is in execution, the end date of the same being 31.12.2024, if it is not denounced, in writing, with 60 days' notice by either party.

Monthly maintenance allowance amount: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €990.98, according to the table of values of the scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_atualizacao-2024.pdf). This amount will be paid monthly by bank transfer.

Other benefits: Personal Accident Insurance.

Applications evaluation:

Applications will be evaluated taking into account the selection criteria set out below.

Selection methods:

The selection method to be used is the final average of the course rounded to the hundredths.

The final ranking of the candidate(s) is given by: **Final_classification_calculation = FA**.
Where FA = Final average of the bachelor's or master's degree (or integrated master's degree).

In case of a tie, students will be ranked by the average of the three curricular units with the highest grade, rounded to the hundredths.

In case of withdrawal of the selected grantees, the sixth candidate will automatically be selected from the ordered list of seriation of accepted candidates and, so on, until the submitted candidates are exhausted.

Participation of interested parties: The candidates will be notified of the draft of the Final Ranking List, by e-mail with delivery receipt of the notification, to comment on the purpose of holding the hearing of the interested parties, pursuant to article 121 et seq. of the Code of Administrative Procedure, to email geral_cicf@ipca.pt. In the absence of a pronouncement by the candidates, the draft of the final ranking list automatically becomes definitive.

Decision Once the prior hearing period has elapsed, or the issues raised within this scope have been considered, the jury draws up the final ranking list of the admitted candidates, submitting it, together with the remaining parts of the procedure, for approval by the IPCA President.

Form of advertising/notification of results: The results of the final evaluation will be publicized, through a list ordered by final grade obtained, and candidates will be notified by e-mail, with delivery receipt of the notification, under the terms of article 16, paragraph 1, of the Regulation of Research Grants of the Polytechnic Institute of Cávado and Ave.

Application deadline and form of submission of applications: The call is open for a period of 10 working days after publication on the <https://euraxess.ec.europa.eu> website.

Applications must be sent exclusively by e-mail to the address: geral_cicf@ipca.pt, duly referenced in the subject line.

Applications must be formalized, mandatorily through a presentation, accompanied by the following documents:

- Curriculum Vitae, with an e-mail address intended to receive notifications within the scope of the scholarship award process and, when applicable, the referring indication of the ORCID portal;
- Certificate of Qualifications of all academic degrees obtained, with the final average and with the classifications in all curricular unites taken;
- Presentation of the record of recognition of foreign academic degrees and conversion of the respective final grades to the Portuguese classification scale, if applicable;
- Proof of enrolment in a master's, integrated master's or doctoral degree or of enrolment in an course not conferring an academic degree;
- Valid civil identification number or passport (in the case of a foreign citizen);
- Declaration that you are not at the same time a beneficiary of any other grant or, if so, that refers to the existence of an agreement between the funding entities;
- Other documents considered relevant to the application.

The Curriculum Vitae and Certificate of Qualifications documents are mandatory documents, the non-delivery of which determines the exclusion. Proof of enrolment in a master's, doctoral or course not conferring an academic degree must be presented until the scholarship is contracted, however, the candidate must present a declaration of honour in which he/she meets the requirements to enrol and that commits, if selected, to proceed with the registration.

If the candidate is not a Portuguese citizen, he/she must provide documentary evidence, at the time of signing the scholarship award contract, that he/she is authorized to remain lawfully in Portuguese territory and that he/she is entitled to enter into the contract that results from the attribution of the scholarship.

If the required qualification has been conferred by a foreign higher education institution, it must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law No. 66/2018, of 16 August, and any formalities established therein must be fulfilled until the date of the signature of the grant contract.

Complaint: Complaints from the final ordering list, duly ratified, may be made to the IPCA president, to be submitted within 15 working days from the notification to the email geral_cicf@ipca.pt, which does not have a suspensive effect.
